



These Picasso-inspired polymer clay pieces will pop with any outfit and can either be worn as a pin or a pendant! The bright color-blends capture the light and moves your eyes around each, but the layers developed using shape, line work and detailed accents provide a depth of interest. Polymer is the perfect medium in which to play with color and shapes in this whimsical take on a 20th Century master artist!

A layered approach using a few simple design elements brings these pieces together – color, shape, lines and detailed accents. Color mixing and color blends are the key to this project and provide the base in which to build. A cut and paste technique is then used, while overlaying line work and accents are the final touch. I will show you how to add a handmade bail or commercial pin back to finish your piece. Because the project is built in steps and baked along the way, you are able to achieve a professional finish.

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
