Fall ink necklace





Essential tools

- Pasta Machine (I will use Atlas brand)
- Blades



- Knitting needles (For smoothing and connecting and piercing)



- Small round cookies cutters – about 10-15 mm



- Baking tile mat (or use paper if you have glossy)
- Texturing sponge (any you have)



It is also good to have:

- Wrapping foil (storage of your sheet for later usage)



- Bowl with cold water
- Favorite finishing components and matching beads (glass, metalics.. anything you like)
- (+ string, OT ending, bunacord.. whatever you like to string your beads on)

CLAY

- I use Premo (but can be Cernit as well)
- Transparent (fresh, not a rock hard dry version LOL! Important) 1x (2oz)
- White clay 1x (2oz)
- Scrap clay (must be same brand you use for inked sheet) (about 2Oz)
- One matching color (for little beads I made turquoise ones, but can be any you like)

<u>ALCOHOL INKS</u> – your favourite brand and colors 2-4 colors, you like, or you have :-D. I use Adirondack and Pinata, but all brands works. (*fall colorscan be : orange, red, yellow, turquoise for example*).

METAL LEAF – I prefer gold, but can be Cooper, or Silver as well.
